CHAPTER 422

PROPERTY — REAL AND PERSONALPUBLIC TRUSTEE AND DEEDS OF TRUST

AN ACT

CONCERNING LEGAL REPRESENTATION FOR THE PUBLIC TRUSTEE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. Article 37 of title 38, Colorado Revised Statutes 1973, 1982 Repl. Vol., is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

38-37-141. Suits against public trustee. When public trustees or county treasurers acting as trustees are sued in their official capacity, the district attorney shall provide legal representation for the public trustees serving in his district, unless such legal representation is provided for otherwise.

Section 2. **Effective date.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1983.

Section 3. **Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
