SEC. 11. All papers, or written contracts, whereto the company are a party, shall be signed by the president and secretary of the company.

SEC. 12. All persons who shall wantonly or maliciously interfere with or injure the said company's ditch, flume, or apurtenances thereunto belonging, shall upon conviction thereof, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than three hundred.

SEC. 13. The said company shall commence work on said flume, on or before the first of July, 1864, and complete the same as far as the mouth of Gold Run, by the first of November, 1864, and between the months of June and November, 1865, to complete the same as far as the mouth of Delaware Flats; and during the summer of 1868, shall be completed to the mouth of Galena gulch, or failing to comply with the provisions of this charter, the same shall be and is hereby declared void.

SEC. 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT

AMENDATORY TO "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE APEX AND GREGORY WAGON ROAD COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of Colorado Territory:

SEC. 1. That the last line of section one be so amended as to read "twenty years," instead of "five years."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved, March 11th, 1864.

AN ACT

TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE CASH CREEK PARK DITCH COMPANY, APPROVED AUG. 4TH, 1862.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of Colorado Territory:

SEC. 1. That all between the words "Cash creek," in the fourteenth line, and the words "the company," in the twentieth line, in section first, be and the same are hereby stricken from said section.
