AN ACT

AMENDATORY OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT REGULATING ELECTIONS," APPROVED NOVEMBER 6TH, 1861.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of Colorado Territory:

SECTION 1. That the word "September," in the third line of the third section of an act entitled "An act regulating elections," approved November 6th, A. D. 1861, be, and the same is hereby stricken out, and the word "August" inserted in lieu thereof.

SEC. 2. That the word "July," in section twelve be, and the same is hereby stricken out, and the word "June" inserted in lieu thereof.

Approved January 24th, A. D. 1866.

General elections henceforth to be held on first Tuesday in August.

Secretary shall notify sheriffs of election of members of legislature, between 1st and 15th of June.

AN ACT

TO SUBMIT TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF WELD COUNTY AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT FOR THE PROTECTION OF FARMERS AGAINST THE DEPREDACTIONS OF STOCK, IN THE COUNTIES OF DOUGLAS AND WELD," APPROVED MARCH 11TH, A. D. 1864.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of Colorado Territory:

SECTION 1. That the act entitled "An act for the protection of farmers against the depredations of stock in the counties of Douglas and Weld," approved March 11th, A. D. 1864, so far as relates to the county of Weld, shall be submitted to a vote of the legal voters of said county, at the next or any general election hereafter, and if said act shall be rejected by a majority of the legal voters of said county, then said act shall be abolished after the first day of December, A. D. 1866, but if not rejected by a majority of said voters, the said act shall remain in force and effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved February 9th, A. D. 1866.

Legal voters of Weld county may vote upon application of herd law of March 11th, 1864, to said county at next general election.
