CHAPTER 85.

APPROPRIATION.

RELIEF OF C. T. RAWALT.

(H. B. No. 133, by Mr. Whiting.)

AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONEY TO PAY C. T. RAWALT HIS CLAIM
AGAINST THE STATE OF COLORADO.*Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

Appropriation.

Section 1. That the sum of ten hundred ninety dollars and thirty-four cents (\$1,090.34) be and the same is hereby appropriated, out of the surplus cash fund, to pay the claim of C. T. Rawalt against the State of Colorado, for publishing notices to electors of proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Colorado, in the year 1894; and the Auditor of the State is hereby authorized to draw his warrant upon the State Treasurer for said amount in favor of the said C. T. Rawalt, upon the passage of this act, and upon surrender to the Auditor of State of all vouchers and claims of said Rawalt.

Emergency.

Section 2. In the opinion of the General Assembly an emergency exists; and therefore, this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
