CHAPTER 41

GEOLOGICAL SURVEY

TRANSFER OF FUNDS

(House Bill No. 54. By Representatives Burch and Best)

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE STATE CONTROLLER TO TRANSFER TO THE GENERAL FUND ANY MONEYS NOW CREDITED TO OR HEREAFTER RECEIVED FOR THE COLORADO GEOLOGICAL SURVEY FUND.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

State Controller
Transfer
Geological
Survey Funds
to General Fund

Section 1. The state controller is hereby authorized to transfer to the general fund any moneys now credited to or hereafter received for the Colorado Geological Survey Fund, created under the provisions of Chapter 75, 1935 Colorado Statutes Annotated.

Safety Clause

Section 2. The General Assembly hereby finds, determines and declares that this Act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.

Approved: February 9, 1954.
