CHAPTER 302

STATUTES—CONSTRUCTION AND REVISION

COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1953

[CRS 135-4-35]

(Senate Bill No. 286. By Senators Carlson, Cheever, Gobble and Brotzman.)

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE PUBLICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF PARTS OF THE STATUTES AND ANNOTATIONS THERE-TO.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1.—Publication without sale—when permitted
—Any person desiring to publish and distribute any part of the statutes of the State of Colorado and annotations thereto shall make written application for permission to the Committee on Statute Revision, stating the portions of the statutes and annotations which the applicant desires to publish and distribute and agreeing not to sell or otherwise take compensation in connection with such distribution. The Committee on Statute Revision, if it deems it not to be detrimental to the interest of the citizens of the state to do so, shall approve said application and authorize the publication and distribution of portions of said statutes and annotations free of any charge to any person receiving any copy of the same.

Section 2. — Safety Clause — The General Assembly hereby finds, determines and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
