TRANSFER OF STATE LANDS IN MESA COUNTY—  
PROCEEDS

(Senate Bill No. 22. By Senator Shults.)

## AN ACT

AMENDING CHAPTER 54, SESSION LAWS OF COLORADO,  
1952.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

Section 1. Section 2, Chapter 54, Session Laws of Colorado, 1952, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.—**Proceeds derived from sale—form of—**  
The proceeds derived from the sale of land described in Section 1 hereof may be received in the form of goods and services usable for the construction of an adequate water supply at the State Home and Training School at Grand Junction, or in the form of cash and credited to the capital outlay fund of the State Home and Training School at Grand Junction, Colorado.

Section 3.—**Safety Clause—**The General Assembly hereby finds, determines and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.

Approved: February 11, 1957.
