AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR OF STATE TO EMPLOY ADDITIONAL CLERICAL ASSISTANCE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF SAME.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. The Auditor of State is hereby authorized to employ, in addition to his deputy, clerical assistance, at a cost not to exceed twelve hundred (\$1,200) dollars in any one calendar year; said assistance to be paid from the appropriation made for the payment of the salaries of officers of the executive department. Auditor may employ clerical assistance.

SEC. 2. Whereas, the duties of the Auditor's office have so increased, and the assistance now being needed, it is the opinion of this General Assembly that an emergency exists; therefore, this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. Emergency.

AN ACT

TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF CLERICAL EXPENSES IN THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized to employ additional clerical assistance for the purpose of completing the recording of papers filed in his office prior to January 1st, A. D. 1883; *Provided*, The Secretary of state may employ additional assistance.
