APPROPRIATING TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE STATE HORTICULTURAL AND FORESTRY ASSOCIATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

\$2.000 appropriated.

SECTION I. There shall be and hereby is appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars, for the use of the Colorado State Horticultural and Forestry horticultural and Association, to be paid one thousand dollars in the year 1889, and one thousand dollars in the year 1890, upon such society complying with the requirements of chapter LIL of the General Statutes of Colorado, entitled "Horticulture."
