AN ACT

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF A PART OF THE ORDINARY EXPENSES OF THE EXECUTIVE, LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL DEPARTMENTS OF THE STATE OF COLORADO FOR THE MONTHS OF DECEMBER, 1920, JANUARY, FEBRUARY AND MARCH, 1921.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Appropriation

Section 29. In the opinion of the General Assembly an emergency exists; therefore, this Act Emergency shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage.

Approved January 25, 1921.
