#### TERMS-FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT

## AN ACT

AMENDING AN ACT FIXING THE TERMS OF THE DISTRICT COURT IN THE FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT, APPROVED APRIL 4, 1917.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section amended

Section 1. That Section 1 of an Act fixing the terms of the District Court in the Fourth Judicial District, approved April 4, 1917, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Counties comprising district

Terms of court

Section 1. The terms of the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District, consisting of the Counties of Cheyenne, Douglas, Elbert, El Paso, Kit Carson, Lincoln and Teller, shall be held in the respective counties as follows, commencing on the following named days in each and every year: In the County of Cheyenne, on the first Tuesday in April and the first Tuesday in October; in the County of Douglas, on the first Monday in November and the second Monday in June; in the County of Elbert, on the fourth Tuesday in May and the second Tuesday in November; in the County of El Paso, on the second Tuesday in January, on the second Tuesday in May and on the second Tuesday in September; in the County of Kit Carson, on the third Tuesday in April and the third Tuesday in October; in the County of Lincoln, on the second

Tuesday in April and second Tuesday in October; and in the County of Teller on the third Tuesday in January, on the third Tuesday in May and on the third Tuesday in September.

Section 2. All Acts and parts of Acts in conflict Repeal with this Act are hereby repealed.

Approved February 17, 1921.
