CHAPTER 70

BANKS AND BANKING

TRUST COMPANIES

(H. B. No. 253, by Mr. Kullerstrand)

AUTHORIZING ANY TRUST COMPANY, INCORPORATED UN-DER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF COLORADO, AND A MEMBER OF A FEDERAL RESERVE BANK, TO COM-PLY WITH THE RESERVE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE ACT IN LIEU OF THOSE ESTAB-LISHED BY THIS STATE.

Re It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. With the approval of the State Bank When bank and Commissioner, any corporation now or hereafter Trust Companies which are memorganized under the laws of this State as a trust combers of Federal Reserve bank may pany or banking trust company, or enjoying and ex- be relieved of State reserve ercising the rights, powers and privileges of a bank laws and trust company, under the laws of the State, if a member of a Federal Reserve Bank, may by a compliance with the requirements of the Federal Reserve Act and the regulations of the Federal Reserve Board as to the maintenance of reserves, be relieved to the requirements of the laws of this State relating to such reserves.

Section 2. All Acts and parts of Acts inconsist-Repeal ent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. In the opinion of the General Assembly an emergency exists; and this Act shall be in Emergence force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
