CHAPTER 265

STATE LANDS—SALE

GAME AND FISH COMMISSION TO UNITED STATES

(House Bill No. 286. By Representatives Porter, Boyden, McNeill, Kane, Compton, Lewis, and Autry; also Senator McCulloch.)

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE GAME AND FISH COMMISSION TO SELL CERTAIN LANDS IN GUNNISON COUNTY TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. (1) The game and fish commission is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey by quit claim deed to the United States of America the following described lands:

The Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) in Section Twenty-six (26), of Township Fifteen (15) South, Range Eighty-five (85) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, except rights of way of record and containing 40 acres, more or less, together with all water, water rights, ditches, ditch rights, and springs used in connection with this tract.

(2) The game and fish commission shall reserve unto the state of Colorado, all oil, gas, and mineral rights in connection therewith.

Section 2. The money derived from the sale of the above described land shall be paid into the game cash fund.

Section 3. The authority herein granted to the game and fish commission to sell the above described tract of land shall terminate December 31, 1964.

Section 4. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
