STATE LANDS — SALE

SALE OF HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT LAND
IN BENT COUNTY

(Senate Bill No. 93. By Senators Hewett, and Hamm; also Representatives O'Donnell, Kane, Burns, P. Massari, Byrne, Wade, and Mackie.)

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS, STATE
OF COLORADO, TO CONVEY CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY
SITUATE IN BENT COUNTY.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. The department of highways, state of Colorado, is hereby authorized to sell or exchange and to execute a conveyance of, by quit claim deed, the following described real property situate in the county of Bent, state of Colorado, to-wit:

A tract or parcel of land in the City of Las Animas, Bent County, in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Township 23 S., Range 52 W., of the 6th P.M. in Bent County, Colorado, said tract or parcel being more particularly described as follows: All of Lots 9 to 14, inclusive, in Block 118, in the Town of Las Animas, Bent County, Colorado.

Section 2. Said conveyance shall be executed on behalf of the department of highways, by its chief engineer and attested to by its chief clerk.

Section 3. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
