CHAPTER 283

STATE LANDS—PURCHASE

STATE PENITENTIARY

(Senate Bill No. 17. By Senator Locks; also Representative Cook.)

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN LANDS BY THE STATE PENITENTIARY, AND MAKING AN AP-PROPRIATION THEREFOR.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1.—Authority to purchase.—The state, for the use and benefit of the state penitentiary, acting by and through the department of institutions, is hereby empowered and authorized to purchase the following described tract of land, including improvements thereon, located in the county of Fremont and state of Colorado, to wit:

A tract of land in Section 1, Township 19 South, Range 70 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Lots fourteen (14) and three (3), Dozier and Mc-Kenzie's Grand View Subdivision, containing 20 acres more or less.

The above described tract of land shall be purchased at a price not to exceed sixteen thousand six hundred sixty-seven dollars (\$16,667).

Section 2.—Appropriation.—There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the penitentiary land income fund not otherwise appropriated, for the current fiscal year, the sum of sixteen thousand six hundred sixtyseven dollars (\$16,667), or so much thereof as may be necessary to the department of institutions for the purchase of the above described tract of land and improvements thereon. Section 3.—Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
