#### CHAPTER 162

#### GAME, FISH AND PARKS

LICENSES AND FEES

(Senate Bill No. 114. By Senators Bledsoe and Shoemaker; also Reprepentative Jackson.)

#### AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE CAME, FISH, AND PARKS DEPART-MENT TO ISSUE A NONRESIDENT ANTELOPE LICENSE. AND PROVIDING THE FEE THEREFOR.

Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section I. 62-3-3 (3) (f), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is hereby amended to read:

62-3-3.—Licenses — class — issuance.—(3) (f) Resident antelope license, AND NONRESIDENT ANTELOPE LICENSE; PROVIDED, THAT NONRESIDENT ANTELOPE LICENSES MAY BE PURCHASED ONLY BY NONRESIDENTS WHO OWN LAND IN COLORADO SUITABLE FOR HUNTING, AND WHO DO NOT POST SUCH LAND AGAINST HUNTING.

Section 2. 62-3-4 (1) (h), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is hereby amended to read:

62-3-4.—Licenses—fees.—(1) (h) Resident antelope license, ten dollars, which shall include storage permit without any additional charge; NONRESIDENT ANTELOPE LICENSE, FIFTEEN DOLLARS, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE THE RIGHT TO TRANSPORT BIG GAME OUT OF THE STATE, TAKEN PURSUANT TO THE LICENSE, WITHOUT ANY ADDITIONAL CHARGE;

Section 3.—Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through woords indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.
