CHAPTER 282

STATE LANDS—PURCHASE

OFF-STREET PARKING—CAPITOL BUILDINGS AREA

(Senate Bill No. 361. By Senators Locke, Shoemaker, and Brown; also Representative MacFarlane.)

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1.—Purchase of property authorized.—Pursuant to provisions of section 134-1-3, C.R.S. 1963, as amended, the purchase of Lots 1 through 8, Block 26, H. C. Brown's Second Addition to Denver, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, is hereby authorized, in the sum of not to exceed four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000), to which shall be applied the option agreement sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), with remodeling and site development authorized in the sum of not to exceed forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000).

Section 2.—Repeal.—Senate Bill No. 154 enacted by the forty-fifth general assembly at the first regular session thereof, and approved by the governor on March 24, 1965, is hereby repealed.

Section 3.—Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
