## A N A C T

AMENDING 72-2-7 (2) (e), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, CONCERNING INVESTMENTS OF DOMESTIC INSURANCE COMPANIES.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

Section 1. 72-2-7 (2) (e), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is amended to read:

72-2-7. **Investments of domestic companies.**—(2) (e) Of solvent corporations, ~~except corporations whose principal business is mining,~~ not in default in the payment of interest on any of their bonds at the time the investment be made;

Section 2. **Safety clause.**—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

*Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.*
