**SCHOOLS II—STATE UNIVERSITIES,
COLLEGES, AND ACADEMIES****STATE COLLEGES—GENERAL PROVISIONS**

A N A C T

AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF THE STATE COLLEGES IN COLORADO TO CEDE JURISDICTION TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE OF THE DRIVEWAYS ON THE CAMPUS OF ANY COLLEGE UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE TRUSTEES, TO THE RESPECTIVE CITIES AND COUNTIES IN WHICH SUCH COLLEGES ARE LOCATED.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. Article 5 of chapter 124, Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, as amended, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 124-5-13 to read:

124-5-13. Trustees authorized to cede jurisdiction of college driveways.—(1) The trustees of the state colleges in Colorado are hereby authorized to cede jurisdiction of the regulation and control of the use of the driveways on the campus of any state college under the jurisdiction of the trustees, to the town, city, or county in which a state college is located, subject to the acceptance of said jurisdiction by the respective town, city, or county.

(2) (a) Upon acceptance of jurisdiction by the town, city, or county, it shall:

(b) Regulate and control the use of the driveways over which jurisdiction is being accepted;

(c) Adopt such regulations as it deems necessary to regulate and control said driveways;

(d) Have authority to enforce such regulations by means of any police powers now or hereafter established by ordinance or resolution, or other provisions of law for the management and control of other streets, highways, and public thoroughfares within the town, city, or county.

(3) Acceptance of jurisdiction to regulate and control the use of the driveways of a state college shall not be deemed to convey any right, title, or interest in said driveways, and the jurisdiction shall extend only to

regulation and control of the use of said driveways, and the state of Colorado reserves the right at all times to revoke the powers hereby granted by act of the general assembly.

Section 2. Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
