CHAPTER 249

AUTOMOBILES AND OTHER MOTOR VEHICLES

OPERATORS AND CHAUFFEURS LICENSES

ANACT

AMENDING 13-4-23 (5), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, CONCERNING THE POINT SYSTEM SCHEDULE FOR SUSPENSION OF LICENSES TO DRIVE MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 18-4-23 (5), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH (x) to read:

13-4-23. Authority to suspend license.—

Type of conviction Points
(5) (x) Eluding or attempting to elude a police officer ______12

Section 2. Effective date—applicability,—This act shall take effect May 1, 1967, and shall apply only to violations committed on or after such date.

Section 3. Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
