CHAPTER 60

OLD AGE PENSIONS

OLD AGE ASSISTANCE LAW

(House Bill No. 1078, By Representative Mackie.)

AN ACT

AMENDING 101-1-5 (4), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, CONCERNING THE OLD AGE PENSION LAW.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 101-1-5 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is amended to read:

101-1-5. Pensions for inmates of public institutions.—(4) It shall be the duty of such chief financial officer to pay monthly from the pension, as prior claim therefrom, all lawful claims of said public institution for the care, support, maintenance, education, and treatment of said inmate in accordance with sections 71-1-16 and 71-1-17 ARTICLE 7 OF CHAPTER 71, C.R.S. 1963.

Section 2. Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.
