CHAPTER 51

SCHOOLS I—PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM

PUBLIC SCHOOL FOUNDATION ACT

(Senate Bill No. 14. By Senators DeBerard and Jackson; also Representatives Braden, Bryant, Edmonds, Fentress, Fowler, Fuhr, Grimshaw, Koster, Lamb, Mackie, McNeil, Morris, Mullen, Quinlan, Schubert, Singer, and Woodfin.

AN ACT

AMENDING 123-6-23 (3) (a), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, INCREASING GRANTS TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY TAX RELIEF FUND.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 128-6-23 (3) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1965 Supp.), as amended by section 1 of chapter 254, Session Laws of Colorado 1967, is amended to read:

123-6-23. School property tax relief.—(3) (a) In addition to any other amounts appropriated by the general assembly for current operation of programs supported by the general fund levy of each school district, each such school district shall be entitled to receive during each calendar year a direct grant of fifty-two SIXTY-FIVE dollars from the public school property tax relief fund for each pupil in average daily attendance, as defined in section 123-6-3, C.R.S. 1963, during the last completed school year.

Section 2. Effective date,-This act shall take effect January 1, 1969.

Section 3. Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.
