CHAPTER 148

#### FEES AND SALARIES

#### COMPENSATION OF COUNTY AND OTHER OFFICERS

(Senate Rill No. 78. By Senator Locke; also Representatives Hinman and Massari.)

### ANACT

AMENDING 56-2-5 (1) (a) AND 56-2-6 (1) (a), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1968, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING THE CLASSIFICATION OF THE COUN-TY OF CLEAR CREEK.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 56-2-5 (1) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1967 Supp.), is amended to read:

56-2-5. Class III.—(1) (a) Class III shall consist of the county of Alamosa; Class IIIA shall consist of the counties of Yuma, Conejos, Chaffee, and Huerfano; Class IIIB shall consist of the counties of CLEAR CREEK, Bent, Lake, Moffat, Kit Carson, Washington, Baca, and Routt; and Class IIIC shall consist of the counties of Gunnison, Lincoln, Rio Blanco, Douglas, and Eagle; and the annual salaries of county officers shall be as follows:

Section 2. 56-2-6 (1) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1967 Supp.), is amended to read:

56-2-6. Class IV.—(1) (a) Class IV shall consist of the counties of Saguache, Phillips, and Sedgwick; Class IVA shall consist of the counties of Costilla, Crowley, Elbert, Grand, and San Miguel; Class IVB shall consist of the counties of <del>Clear Creek</del>, Cheyenne, Archuleta, Teller, Kiowa, and Pitkin; Class IVC shall consist of the counties of Dolores, Summit, and Park; and the annual salaries of county officers shall be as follows:

Section 3. Effective date.—This act shall take effect July 1, 1969, and shall apply only to those officers elected or appointed on or after such date.

Section 4. Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
