## A N A C T

AMENDING 139-49-3, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, CONCERNING  
THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN MONEYS TO POLICEMEN'S PENSION  
FUND.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

Section 1. 139-49-3, Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is amended to read:

§ 139-49-3. Transfer of certain moneys to policemen's pension fund.—On the thirtieth day of April, 1961 1970, and on the thirtieth day of April of each year thereafter, the state treasurer shall transfer the sum of ~~six hundred thousand~~ ONE MILLION dollars from the revenues derived from the tax imposed by section 72-1-14, Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, AS AMENDED, on the gross amount of all premiums collected from foreign or alien insurance companies, as computed by the commissioner of insurance, which are authorized and licensed by said commissioner to make insurance or reinsurance in this state in accordance with the provisions of section 72-1-41, C.R.S. 1963, and specifically by subsections (2), (4) (e), (4) (f), (4) (g), (4) (j), (4) (k), and (5), of said section, to a fund to be known as the policemen's pension fund.

Section 2. Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
