CHAPTER 282

ROADS AND HIGHWAYS**ROADSIDE ADVERTISING**

(House Bill No. 1134. By Representatives Sack, Friedman, Baer, and Showalter.)

A N A C T**AMENDING 120-5-16, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING ROADSIDE ADVERTISING.**

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 120-5-16, Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1967 Supp.), as amended by section 1 of chapter 59, Session Laws of Colorado 1968, is **REPEALED AND RE-ENACTED, WITH AMENDMENTS**, to read:

120-5-16. Expiration of sections 120-5-11 to 120-5-16—suspension of other laws.—Sections 120-5-11 to 120-5-16, as amended, shall remain in force and effect until February 28, 1970, and shall be null and void thereafter. All the provisions of sections 120-5-1 to 120-5-10, as amended, which are inconsistent with sections 120-5-11 to 120-5-16, as amended, shall be temporarily suspended for the duration of said sections 120-5-11 to 120-5-16, as amended. Nothing in said sections 120-5-11 to 120-5-16, as amended, shall be construed to temporarily suspend any provision of sections 120-5-1 to 120-5-10, as amended, which provisions are designed to qualify this state for payments made available to those states which meet federal standards of roadside advertising control along the interstate system. Upon the expiration of sections 120-5-11 to 120-5-16, as amended, all provisions of sections 120-5-1 to 120-5-10, as amended, shall again become of full force and effect unless repealed or amended by the general assembly.

Section 2. **Safety clause.**—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
