AMENDING 148-18-15, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING CERTAIN FEES COLLECTED BY THE STATE ENGINEER UNDER THE COLORADO GROUND WATER MANAGEMENT ACT.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 148-18-15 (1) (e), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1965 Supp.), is amended, and the said 148-18-15 is further amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION (2) to read:

148-18-15. Fees.—(1) (e) Making a copy of a document filed in his office, \$1.00 \$.50 per page or fraction thereof.

(2) Departments and agencies of the state of Colorado shall be exempt from the payment of fees for applications for the use of ground water or for a permit to construct a well.

Section 2. Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.
