AMENDING 31-1-2 (15), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, DEFINING THE TERM "DUPLICATE ORIGINALS" CONTAINED IN THE "COLORADO CORPORATION CODE".

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 31-1-2 (15), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is amended to read:

31-1-2. Definitions.—(15) "Duplicate originals" means each instrument TYPED AND executed in duplicate by all parties, or true copy made when the original was made or copy made by photostat, picture or other process from the original, WHICH RESULTING COPY MUST BE BLACK TYPE ON WHITE PAPER.

Section 2. **Safety clause.**—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.
