AUTHORIZING THE STATE OF COLORADO TO CONVEY CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY SITUATE IN MESA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. State authorized to sell or exchange land.-The state of Colorado is hereby authorized to sell or exchange, and to execute a conveyance of, by quit claim deed, the following described real property situate in the county of Mesa, state of Colorado, to wit:

A tract or parcel of land located in the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW1/4 SE1/4) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township One (1) South, Range One (1) West of the Ute Meridian, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the South line of the said Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW1/4 SE1/4) of said Section 26 from which point the south quarter corner of said Section 26 bears westerly a distance of 310 feet; thence north a distance of 225 feet; thence east parallel with the south line of said section a distance of 225 feet; thence south a distance of 225 feet to the south line of said Section 26, thence west along the south line of said section a distance of 225 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. Governor to execute conveyance.—Said conveyance shall be executed on behalf of the state of Colorado by the governor of the state of Colorado.

Section 3. Disposition of proceeds of sale.—Any funds derived from the sale of these lands shall be deposited in the state highway supplementary fund.

Section 4. Safety clause.—The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
