ANACT

AMENDING 31-24-2, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED. DEFINING THE TERM "DUPLICATE ORIGINALS" IN THE "COLORADO NONPROFIT CORPORATION ACT".

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

I LLT. B HT

Section 1. 31-24-2, Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1967 Supp.), is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

31-24-2. Definitions.-(11) "Duplicate originals" means each instru-ment typed and executed in duplicate by all parties, or true copy made when the original was made or copy made by picture or other process from the original, which resulting copy must be black type on white paper.

Section 2. Safety clause .- The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
