**A N A C T**

AMENDING 148-18-3 (4) AND (5), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING THE GROUND WATER COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

Section 1. 148-18-3 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1967 Supp.), is amended to read:

**148-18-3. Commission — organization — expenses.—**(4) The natural resources coordinator, the state engineer, and the director of the state water conservation board shall be voting members of the commission. ~~Eight~~ **SEVEN** voting members shall constitute a quorum at any regularly OR **SPECIALLY** called meeting of the commission, and a majority vote of those present shall rule. The commission shall establish and maintain, ~~as nearly as may be practicable,~~ a schedule of four general meetings each year. **THE CHAIRMAN, AT HIS DISCRETION, MAY CALL SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE COMMISSION TO DISPOSE OF ACCUMULATED BUSINESS.**

Section 2. 148-18-3 (5), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1965 Supp.), is amended to read:

**148-18-3. Commission — organization — expenses.—**(5) Members of the commission shall be paid no compensation, but shall be paid actual necessary expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties as members thereof and a per diem equal in amount to per diem payments made to members of other state commissions of a similar general character **OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS PER DAY WHILE PERFORMING OFFICIAL DUTIES, NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS IN ANY YEAR.**

Section 3. **Safety clause.—**The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
