SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICTS

Senate Bill No. 232. By Senator Anderson; also Representative Sonnenberg.

AN ACT

AMENDING 128-1-8 (13), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, CONCERNING AUDITS OF SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 128-1-8 (13), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is RE-PEALED AND REENACTED, WITH AMENDMENTS, to read:

128-1-8. Powers and duties of districts. (13) To cause annual audits to be made in accordance with the "Colorado Local Government Audit Law".

Section 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
