CHAPTER 211

INTOXICATING LIQUORS

LIQUOR CODE OF 1935

Senate Bill No. 276. By Senators G. Jackson, Ohlson, Brown, Kinnie, Kogovsek, and Plock; also Representatives Baer, Bishop, Burns, Byerly, Koster, Mullen, Pepper, Showaiter, DeMoulin, and Strang.

ANACT

AMENDING 75-2-3 (3), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, CONCERNING THE SALE, SERVING, OR DISTRIBUTION OF MALT, VINOUS, OR SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS ON ELECTION DAYS.

Be it cnacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 75-2-3 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is amended to read:

75-2-3. Unlawful acts. (3) To sell, serve, or distribute any malt, vinous, or spirituous liquors on any primary OR general or municipal election day, AS DEFINED BY ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 49, C.R.S. 1963, during polling; or on Sunday and Christmas except as permitted under subsection (4) of this section. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION (3) SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY OTHER ELECTION HELD IN THIS STATE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ELECTIONS HELD PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 25 OF CHAPTER 49, CHAPTER 89, CHAPTER 123, AND CHAPTER 124, C.R.S. 1963.

Section 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.

Section 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
