CHAPTER 362

TRADES: BUILDING AND MECHANICAL

ELECTRICIANS

House Bill No. 1424. By Representatives DeMoulin, Edmonds, Mullen, Newman, and Pepper.

ANACT

AMENDING 142-2-17 (2), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING INSPECTIONS OF ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 142-2-17 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1965 Supp.), is amended to read:

142-2-17. Inspection — application — standards. (2) Any electrical installation in any new construction or remodeling or repair, except in any incorporated town or city, or any county, or ANY city and county having its own electrical code and inspection equal to the minimum standards as are provided in this article, shall be inspected by a state electrical inspector. ALL NEW MOBILE HOMES, TRAVEL TRAILERS, MODULAR HOMES, AND CAMPERS SHALL, IN ADVANCE OF SALE TO THE PUBLIC, BE INSPECTED BY A STATE ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR EITHER AT THE PLACE OF MANUFACTURE OR UPON THE VENDOR'S PREMISES. Prior to the commencement of any such electrical installation, OR PRIOR TO THE SALE TO THE PUBLIC OF ANY NEW MOBILE HOME, TRAVEL TRAILER, MODULAR HOME, OR CAMPER, the person making such installation OR THE VENDOR shall make application for inspection and pay the required fee or fees therefor.

Section 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.

Section 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
