SCHOOLS II — STATE UNIVERSITIES, COLLEGES, AND ACADEMIES

WORK STUDY PROGRAMS — INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION

House Bill No. 1360. By Representatives Bishop, Baer, Bain, Chestnutt, Davidson, Gallagher, Hart, Knox, Koster, Lamb, Lucero, Miller, Porter, Shore, Showalter, Sonnenberg, Stonebraker, Strang, Valdez, Younglund, Burns, Carroll, DeMoulin, Friedman, Pepper, and Safran; also Senators Enstrom, Anderson, Noble, Ohlson, Taylor, Brown, Calabrese, Cisneros, MacManus, and Ruland.

ANACT

AMENDING 124-22-23, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF WORK STUDY PROGRAMS AT STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION BY THE COLORADO COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 124-22-23 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1969 Supp.), is amended to read:

124-22-23. Work study program — use of funds. (1) The Colorado commission on higher education is hereby directed to establish a work study program in the state institutions of higher education, SUPPORTED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY STATE FUNDS, in cooperation with such institutions of higher education. The work study program shall be designed to provide employment for qualifying students in good standing with the institution, in positions which are directly under the control of the institution of higher education providing such position. Only such positions as are under institutional control shall be included in and be eligible for funding under the work study program. Any student who is a resident of the state of Colorado and who is enrolled or accepted for enrollment in an undergraduate division of a state AN institution of higher education, SUP-PORTED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY STATE FUNDS, shall be eligible to qualify for participation in the work study program established pursuant to this section.

Section 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
