## A N A C T

AMENDING 13-2-6 (2), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, CONCERNING FEES CHARGED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

Section 1. 13-2-6 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963, is amended to read:

13-2-6. Records open to inspection — furnishing of copies. (2) Upon written application and the payment of a fee of ~~seventy-five~~ ONE DOLLAR AND TWENTY-FIVE cents per copy, OR SEARCH THEREFOR, for each copy requested, the department shall furnish to any person, firm, corporation, or association a photostatic copy of any specified record or accident report specifically made a public record by any provision of this chapter and will for the additional fee of fifty cents per certification, if requested, certify the same. All fees collected under the provisions of this subsection shall be used to defray the expenses of providing such copies.

Section 2. **Effective date.** This act shall take effect July 1, 1971.

Section 3. **Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
