ANACT

AMENDING 35-3-19 (1) (e), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING COUNTY CLERKS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 35-3-19 (1) (e), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1969 Supp.), is amended to read:

35-3-19. Clerk of board — duties. (1) (e) EXCEPT WHEN SPE-CIFICALLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE BY LAW, sign all orders issued by the board for the payment of money.

Section 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
