## AN ACT

AMENDING 82-4-10 (3), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING DEDUCTIONS FROM UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

Section 1. 82-4-10 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1965 Supp.), is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

**82-4-10. Other remuneration.** (3) (e) Payments received by veterans of the United States armed forces for service-connected disabilities or for retirement from the United States armed forces based on disability shall be excluded from the provisions of this subsection (3).

**Section 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
