## AN ACT

AMENDING A CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION APPROPRIATION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO.

*Be It enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

Section 1. Subsection (4) (N) (i) of section 3 of chapter 15, Session Laws of Colorado 1970, is amended to read:

Section 2. **Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
