REGULATION OF RATES AND CHARGES

AN ACT

AMENDING 115-3-5, COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING THE FURNISHING BY A PUBLIC UTILITY OF ITS SERVICES, PRODUCTS, OR COMMODITIES TO CERTAIN PERSONS AT NO CHARGE OR FOR REDUCED CHARGES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 115-3-5, Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1969 Supp.), is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

115-3-5. Free and reduced service or transportation prohibited — exceptions. (3) (a) Nothing in this article shall prohibit or restrict any public utility from furnishing its service, product, or commodity to, or the receiving of its service, product, or commodity by, its employees, pensioners, officers, directors, or board members at no charge or at charges less than those prescribed in the utility's published schedules or tariffs.

(b) No revenue shall accrue or be credited in the accounts of such utility with respect to such service, product, or commodity furnished at no charge nor with respect to any amounts by which charges for such service, product, or commodity are less than those prescribed in the utility's published schedules or tariffs.

Section 2. **Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.
