REFUNDS OF MONEY ERRONEOUSLY OR ILLEGALLY
COLLECTED

(House Bill No. 370. By Representative Steele)

A N A C T

AUTHORIZING REFUNDS OF MONEY ERRONEOUSLY OR
ILLEGALLY COLLECTED BY THE STATE OF COLO-
RADO.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. In all cases not otherwise provided for by specific Statute, whenever any money not owed or belonging to the State of Colorado is collected or received by the State of Colorado through mistake either of law or of fact, upon proper showing made to the satisfaction of the head of the Department of the State of Colorado which collected or received such money, and upon proper voucher drawn by such Department head and approved by the Governor and State Treasurer, the State Treasurer is hereby authorized to draw a warrant to refund such money to the person from whom it was collected or received. Such refund shall be made from the fund into which such money was deposited. No refund made under the authority of this Section shall be made unless a claim therefor is filed within one year after such money is collected or received by the State of Colorado.

Section 2. Nothing in this Act shall alter, modify or amend the procedure, time of filing claims or methods of processing or paying refunds specifically provided for in other Statutes.

Section 3. The General Assembly hereby finds, determines and declares that this Act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.

Section 4. In the opinion of the General Assembly an emergency exists; therefore, this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
