CHAPTER 55

DRUGS AND DRUGGISTS

DANGEROUS DRUG ACT

HOUSE BILL NO. 1085. BY REPRESENTATIVES Strahle, Arnold, Baer, Bishop, Bryant, DeMoulin, Eckelberry, Gaon, Hayes, Herzberger, Koster, Kramer, Lucero, Moore, Ross, Showalter, Strang, Tempess, and Wells; also SENATORS McCormick, Cole, Stockhon, and Strickland.

AN ACT

AMENDING 48-8-1 (2) (b), COLORADO REVISED STATUTES 1963, AS AMENDED, AND DEFINING METHAQUALONE AND ITS SALTS AS DEPRESSANT DRUGS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 48-8-1 (2) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes 1963 (1969 Supp.), is amended to read:

48-8-1. Definitions. (2) (b) Barbituric acid, allylbarbituric acid, aprobarbital, beta-bromoallyl secondary-amylbarbituric acid, butallylonal, diallyl barbituric acid, barbital, hexobarbital, dipropylbarbituric acid, butethal, butabarbital, cyclobarbital, hexethal, amobarbital, pentobarbital, thiopental, vinbarbital, mephobarbital, propallylonal, phenylmethylbarbituric acid, secobarbital, phenobarbital, probarbital, and their salts, and any other derivatives of barbituric acid and their salts, AND METHAQUALONE AND ITS SALTS;

Section 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.
