CHAPTER 73

PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

SENATE BILL NO. 12. BY SENATORS Minister, Allshouse, Anderson, and Kadlecak; also REPRESENTATIVES DeMoulin, Barragan, Bledsoe, Boley, Flett, Gustafson, Marks, and Munson.

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING RETAIL LIQUOR STORES TO SELL NONFOOD ITEMS RELATED TO THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. 12-47-103 (22), Colorado Revised Statutes 1973, as amended by Senate Bill No. 65, enacted at the Second Regular Session of the Fiftieth General Assembly and approved by the Governor on April 29, 1976, is amended to read:

12-47-103. Definitions. (22) "Retail liquor store" means an establishment engaged only in the sale of malt, vinous, and spirituous liquors and soft drinks and mixers, all in sealed containers for consumption off the premises, and in the sale of tobaccos, tobacco products, and smokers' supplies, AND NONFOOD ITEMS RELATED TO THE CONSUMPTION OF SUCH BEVERAGES.

Section 2. 12-47-116, Colorado Revised Statutes 1973, as amended by Senate Bill No. 65, enacted at the Second Regular Session of the Fiftieth General Assembly and approved by the Governor on April 29, 1976, is amended to read:

12-47-116. Retail liquor store license. A retail liquor store license shall be issued to persons selling only malt, vinous, and spirituous liquors in sealed containers not to be consumed at the place where sold. Malt, vinous, and spirituous liquors in sealed containers shall not be sold at retail other than in retail liquor stores except as provided in section 12-47-117. IN ADDITION, RETAIL LIQUOR STORES MAY SELL NONFOOD ITEMS RELATED TO THE CONSUMPTION OF SUCH LIQUORS.

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.

Section 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

Editor's note: Although this act does not contain an effective date, this bill amends Senate Bill No. 65, which is effective, July 1, 1976; therefore, this act (Senate Bill No. 12) is not effective or operative until July 1, 1976.
